- VD presented the program plan in the new format and outlined the proposed changes to the model BSIS program plan.
- The UGC voted on the following changes and approved them (4 for, 0 against, 0 abstained):

 Introduce a new Introduction to Information Science course that introduces the topics in the BSIS core more inclusively, striking a balance between the three main realms of interest (Information, People, and Technology). The proposed number for the new version of the course is INST 101, and it may have a different, catchier title.

- Replace the current INST 301 with this new course (INST 101) on the Fall 2016 schedule.

- Keep INST 301 as Information Science Foundations for Non-Majors

- Substitute Technology and Society (as the second people course) in place of Professional Writing as a major core course; (that is, the 11th core course.)

- VD will take these changes to the iSchool PCC for approval, after which the university approval will be pursued.
- JB gave an update on the development of undergraduate student services.
- VD gave an update on the development and approval of undergraduate courses.
